

****DEPUTY'S SUPPLEMENTAL REPORT****

On 9/18/21 at approximately 1902 hours I, (Pace), responded to assist Deputy Mohawk with an in-progress physical family dispute at 10571 N Camp Ct, Hayden ID.

Deputy Mohawk and I contacted and detained a male, O-Luke E. Sommer. While Deputy Mohawk interviewed the other parties, I stayed with Luke and read him Miranda. Luke said that he understood and wanted to speak to me. Luke had glassy bloodshot eyes and had the odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from his breath and person. Luke's speech was slurred. Based on my training and experience, I believe that Luke was heavily intoxicated.

any medical attention. I photographed his injuries and uploaded them to KCSO Evidence.

Luke said that he attempted to leave for work and told him he was too drunk to drive.

Luke would not tell me the nature of the fight or to a question about how he got injured Luke said "he had not been in a fight with his brother since they were 14."

Luke was placed under citizen's arrest by his brother for battery.

I had no further involvement in this case.
